2018 Pearmain Prize for Excellence in Research on Aging **Nomination Form**

The University of Southern California (USC) Edward R. Roybal Institute on Aging fosters and recognizes excellence in research and community partnerships that further the needs of minority older persons, particularly those from underserved backgrounds. Toward that end, the USC Suzanne Dworak-Peck School of Social Work established the Pearmain Prize for Excellence in Research on Aging in 2010 on behalf of the institute.

The **Pearmain Prize for Excellence in Research on Aging** gives special recognition to an outstanding senior scholar who has made outstanding contributions to the field of translational aging research that demonstrates excellence in bridging science to practice and/or policy. This prize is not designed to recognize a single major research project but a sustained body of work throughout the scholar's career. The recipient of this prize will deliver remarks based on her/his record of accomplishment and implications for practice during the bi-annual Edward R. Roybal Memorial Lecture. The recipient will also meet with faculty and doctoral students to discuss the future of translational aging research and careers in aging.

Submission: Please complete one form per nominee. No person may self-nominate. Completed nominations are due by **October 31, 2017**. *Submissions will only be accepted via email or fax.*

Nominees will be contacted within five working days after nomination submission. Winners will be notified by December 1, 2017.

Criteria For Excellence

To be eligible for the award, the research should have (1) generated new knowledge or substantially reinterpreted existing knowledge, (2) fostered the development of theory and explanations of aging, and directly contributed to the understanding and solution of important issues facing older persons and (3) made outstanding contributions to translational research.
